A record-breaking 91.4% of RWHAP clients receiving HIV medical care

reached viral suppression*

in 2024 compared with 69.5% in 2010, which means they cannot sexually transmit HIV to their partners and can live longer and healthier lives.

An increase of 4.9 percentage points



in viral suppression occurred from 2020 to 2024 among youth and young adult patients aged 24 and younger.






Percentage of People with Diagnosed HIV Served by the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program, 2024—United States and 3 Territories^a














The Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program client population is aging: the percentage of clients aged 50 years and older grew by 15 percentage points from 2010–2024



47.4% of RWHAP clients are aged 50 years and older.





Clients Served by the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program, by Age Group and Race/Ethnicity, 2024—United States and 3 Territories^a



Clients Served by the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program, by Sex, 2024 — United States and 3 Territories^a






Clients Served by the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program, by Race/Ethnicity and Sex, 2024 — United States and 3 Territories^a





What is 100% FPL?

In 2024, individuals earning **\$15,060** or households of four earning **\$31,200** are at **100% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL)**.

FPL varies by household size and is updated annually.








Clients Served by the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program, by Sex and Federal Poverty Level, 2024—United States and 3 Territories^a



Clients Served by the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program, by Housing Status, 2010 and 2024—United States and 3 Territories^a






Clients Served by the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program, by Age Group and Housing Status, 2024—United States and 3 Territories^a





Trends in Viral Suppression Among Patients Served by the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program



Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program Viral Suppression vs. National Viral Suppression

Viral suppression among Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program (RWHAP) clients receiving HIV medical care **exceeds the national average** of all people with diagnosed HIV

91.4%

Viral suppression among **RWHAP clients receiving HIV medical care** (2024)

67.2%

Viral suppression among **all people with diagnosed HIV** in the United States (2023)




Viral Suppression among Patients Served by the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program (non-ADAP), 2010–2024—United States and 3 Territories^a




Viral Suppression among Populations Served by the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program, 2010 and 2024—United States and 3 Territories^a

The Top 10 Most Common Services Delivered by Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program Providers (non-ADAP), 2024





Increase of over 40,000 clients served by the RWHAP since 2020
