By the Numbers: 2024

The Health Resources and Services Administration's (HRSA) Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program (RWHAP) Part F AIDS Education and Training Center (AETC) Program strengthens and expands the HIV health care workforce to improve patient outcomes across the HIV care continuum and reduce HIV transmissions.

From July 2023 through June 2024, RWHAP regional AETCs trained
